State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue

Roadway Project Begins Week of January 12

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of January 12, 2015. The project limits extend along State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue from south of SR 934/NW 79 Street to north of SR 932/NW 103 Street in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$4.1 million. The work will take roughly one year to complete and includes the following:

- Installing underground drainage structures and pipes
- Replacing sections of curb, gutter and sidewalk
- Replacing several existing traffic signals
- Installing new countdown pedestrian signals at intersections
- Modifying existing median locations
- Installing new directional medians
- Rebuilding sections of roadway
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Installing new signage and pavement markings

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and implement detours at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving.
