Reduction of NW 25 Street Eastbound Left-Turn Lanes to Northbound SR 826 from Two Lanes to One Lane

(Weekend closure of eastbound NW 25 Street from NW 79 Avenue to SR 826)

DORAL, FL – On Monday, morning, January, 26, there will only be one left-turn lane on eastbound NW 25 Street to northbound SR 826 between NW 78 Avenue and SR 826; the one turn lane will open up to two lanes in the area under SR 826. In addition, all eastbound travel lanes on NW 25 Street between NW 79 Avenue and State Road (SR) 826 will be shifted to the south side of the roadway. These changes will allow the contractor to construct the eastbound viaduct bridge and will remain in place until the end of the project.

In order to complete the traffic shift the following closures will be scheduled:

All eastbound travel lanes on NW 25 Street will be closed from NW 79 Avenue to State Road (SR) 826 at 8 p.m., Friday, January 23 until 5:30 a.m., Monday, January 26.

Eastbound drivers on NW 25 Street can:

- Turn north on NW 79 Avenue
- East on NW 36 Street
- South on SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street

The eastbound NW 25 Street on ramp to southbound SR 826 will be closed at 8 p.m., Friday, January 23 until 5:30 a.m., Monday, January 26.

- Turn north on NW 79 Avenue
- East on NW 36 Street to connect with the southbound SR 826 ramp

The westbound NW 25 Street turn lane to southbound SR 826 will be closed at 8 p.m., Friday, January 23 until 5:30 a.m., Monday, January 26.

- Continue west on NW 25, turn north on NW 79 Avenue
- East on NW 36 Street to connect with the southbound SR 826 ramp
