FDOT to Host Public Hearing for Two Roadway Projects

State Road (SR) 5/US-1

Miami, FL – Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will hold a public hearing for two roadway projects along State Road (SR) 5/US-1 from Santana Street to Granada Boulevard and at the intersection of Grand Avenue.

The public hearing will be held **from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, January 27, 2015 at Coral Gables Library, 3443 Segovia Street, Coral Gables, Florida 33134**. Attendees may arrive at any time from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Graphic displays of the projects will be shown and FDOT staff will be on hand to discuss the projects and answer questions.

The proposed work for these projects includes:

- Repaving and resurfacing the road as needed
- Upgrading pedestrian signage and pavement markings
- Updating traffic signals
- Extending left-turn lanes at several locations
- Relocating existing trees impacted by roadway widening
- Installing new traffic signs and signals to provide a dedicated lane for westbound left turns at Grand Avenue
- Widening the road at Granada Boulevard to create a southbound right-turn lane
- Reconstructing the concrete median at the intersection of Augusto Street and the frontage road to restrict any eastbound, northbound and southbound left-turn movements
- Installing high emphasis pedestrian crosswalks at the intersections of Alhambra Circle, Augusto Street, and Granada Boulevard

Construction is expected to begin in July 2016 and last about five months. The estimated construction cost of the projects is \$786,495.
