## **State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Express Project Nighttime Lanes, Road Closures and Detours**

---

**Miami, FL** – The contractor for the Palmetto Express project will be paving shoulders, removing stripes, and realigning lanes toward the median. In order to conduct this work, the following nighttime lane, road closures, and detours will be in effect:

**From Friday, January 23 through Sunday, January 25, 2015, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., the following morning:**

Two southbound lanes along SR 826/Palmetto Expressway will be closed from the I-75 Interchange to NW 103 Street/West 49 Street.

**From Monday, February 2 to Tuesday, February 3, 2015, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning,** possible alternate night would be Wednesday, February 4, 2015:

**ALL** southbound lanes will be closed between NW 154 Street and NW 122 Street/West 68 Street.

Southbound drivers can:

- Go west on NW 154 Street
- Turn south on NW 87 Avenue/West 28 Avenue
- Turn east on NW 122 Street/ West 68 Street to access the on-ramp to southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway

**On Wednesday, February 4, 2015, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., the following morning:**

**ALL** southbound lanes will be closed between NW 122 Street/West 68 Street and NW 103 Street/West 49 Street.

- Go west on NW 122 Street/West 68 Street
- Turn south on West 24 Avenue
- Turn east on NW 103 Street/West 49 Street to access the on-ramp to southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
