## **Daytime & Nighttime Westbound Lane Closures**

*I-395/MacArthur Causeway between west end of bridge to west of Parrot Jungle Trail*

---

**Miami, FL** – One lane on westbound I-395/MacArthur Causeway will be closed between the west end of bridge to west of Parrot Jungle Trail on Wednesday, February 4 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Two travel lanes will remain open at all times. In addition, on Friday, February 6 at midnight to Saturday, February 7 at 8 a.m., one lane will close at 12 a.m. to 8 a.m., followed by a double lane closure between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. One travel lane will remain open at all times. The designated u-turn behind the Watson Island Tunnel Operations Facility will also be temporarily closed. Drivers heading eastbound wishing to make a u-turn to access westbound MacArthur Causeway will need to make the u-turn at Fountain Street.

These closures will allow the workers to perform emergency utility work. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
