## SR 826/Palmetto Express Project Nighttime Lanes, Road Closures and Detours on Southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway and on SR 924/Gratigny Parkway at the SR 826/Palmetto Expressway Interchange

*Miami*, *FL* – The contractor for the Palmetto Express project will be milling and paving shoulders for the upcoming traffic switch as well as removing stripes and realigning lanes. ## **CLOSURE AND DETOUR ON SR 826/PALMETTO EXPRESSWAY**

On Tuesday February 10, 2015, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. of the following morning. Alternate night would be Wednesday, February 11, 2015:

<u>ALL</u> southbound lanes will be closed between NW 122 Street/West 68 Street and NW 103 Street/West 49 Street.

## Southbound drivers can:

- Go west on NW 122 Street/West 68 Street
- Turn south on West 24 Avenue
- Turn east on NW 103 Street/West 49 Street to access the on-ramp to southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway

## **CLOSURES AND DETOURS ON SR 924/GRATIGNY PARKWAY**

On Tuesday, February 10, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. of the following morning. Alternate night would be Wednesday, February 11, 2015:

Two outside lanes will be closed on eastbound SR 924/Gratigny Parkway from the west side to the east side of SR 826/Palmetto Expressway.

On Wednesday, February 11, 2015 from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning. Alternate night would be Thursday, February 12, 2015:

Two outside lanes will be closed on westbound SR 924/Gratigny Parkway from the east side to the west side of SR 826/Palmetto Expressway.

On Thursday, February 12, 2015 from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. of the following morning. Alternate nights would be Sunday, February 15, 2015:

<u>ALL</u> eastbound lanes will be closed on SR 924/Gratigny Parkway at the SR 826/Palmetto Expressway interchange.

Eastbound drivers on SR 924/Gratigny Parkway can:

- Take the southbound on-ramp to SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Exit on NW 103 Street/West 49 Street and stay on the off- ramp's far left lane
- Turn east (left) on NW 103 Street/West 49 Street and go under the overpass
- Take the northbound on-ramp to SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Take the eastbound on-ramp to SR 924/Gratigny Parkway

Also on Thursday, February 12, 2015 from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. of the following morning. Alternate nights would be Sunday, February 15, 2015:

On southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway the access from the off-ramp at NW 138 Street to eastbound SR 924/Gratigny Parkway will be closed.

Drivers on southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway heading to eastbound SR 924/Gratigny Parkway can:

- Continue southbound on SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Exit on NW 103 Street/West 49 Street and stay on the off- ramp's far left lane
- Turn east (left) on NW 103 Street/West 49 Street and go under the overpass
- Take the northbound on-ramp to SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Take the eastbound on-ramp to SR 924/Gratigny Parkway

On Sunday, February 15, 2015 from 11p.m. to 5 a.m. of the following morning. Alternate night would be Monday, February 16, 2015:

<u>ALL</u> westbound lanes will be closed on SR 924/Gratigny Parkway at the SR 826/Palmetto Expressway interchange.

Westbound drivers on SR 924/Gratigny Parkway can:

- Turn north to access the off-ramp to NW 154 Street
- Go west (left) on NW 154 Street
- Take the southbound on-ramp to SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Take the westbound on-ramp to SR 924/Gratigny Parkway
