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Governor Scott Proclaims March Florida Bicycle Month

Tallahassee – An official proclamation was signed by Governor Scott on Friday, February 27, 2015, recognizing March as Florida Bicycle Month. Bicycling plays an important role in providing transportation to work, school, for fitness and recreational activities to millions of Florida residents and visitors annually.

“More and more people are using bicycles as a transportation option.” said Lora Hollingsworth, FDOT Chief Safety Officer. “The people riding bikes are neighbors, friends, and co-workers, so remember to give them space and keep them safe.”

The Florida Department of Transportation has a focused initiative to reduce crashes, fatalities, and injuries involving pedestrians and bicyclists.
