Traffic Pattern Change and Lane Reduction on NW 87 Avenue

Doral, FL – On Friday, March 13 (Monday, March 16 is an alternate date), all traffic on NW 87 Avenue between NW 21 Terrace and NW 27 Street will be shifted to the east side of the roadway and the travel lanes will be reconfigured as follows:

Lane configuration on NW 87 Avenue between NW 21 Terrace and NW 27 Street:

- **Northbound** travel lanes on NW 87 Avenue will be reduced to two through lanes, one left turn lane and one right turn lane.
- **Southbound** travel lanes on NW 87 Avenue will be reduced to two through lanes and one left turn lane.

This traffic pattern is expected to be in place for approximately one month and will allow the contractor to reconstruct the west side of NW 87 Avenue. In order to prepare for the traffic pattern change, the contractor will close two northbound and two southbound lanes on NW 87 Avenue between NW 21 Terrace and NW 27 Street on Thursday night, March 12, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
