Major Traffic Pattern Change on Westbound State Road (SR) 836, Exits to SR 826 Moving to the Right

Miami, FL – On Sunday, March 22, the westbound SR 836 exit ramps to northbound and southbound SR 826 will be moved to the right-hand side of the expressway. Westbound drivers on SR 836 exiting to SR 826, West Flagler Street or NW 87 Avenue will need to exit utilizing the right two lanes after the NW 72 Avenue ramp. Drivers on westbound SR 836 continuing west will need to stay on the left three lanes.

Drivers traveling on westbound SR 836 should pay close attention to signage, overhead and portable electronic message boards as they will all be displaying updated directional information.

In order to complete the traffic pattern change the following closures will be scheduled: All westbound SR 836 travel lanes will be closed at the NW 72 Avenue exit ramp on Saturday, March 21, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue
- South on NW 72 Avenue
- West on NW 11 Street, cross Milam Dairy Road to access westbound SR 836 and SR 826 ramps

On Saturday, March 21, there will be a traffic pacing operation on the westbound SR 836 entrance ramp from NW 11 Street and the southbound SR 826 ramp to eastbound SR 836 between the hours of 11:45 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The southbound SR 826 ramp to westbound SR 836 will be closed on Saturday, March 21, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:
