State Road (SR) 5/US-1/Overseas Highway from Mile Marker (MM) 99.6 to MM 106.3

Landscaping project begins in April 2015

Monroe County, FL – During the week of April 6, 2015, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a landscaping project along SR 5/US-1/Overseas Highway from MM 99.6 north of Atlantic Avenue to MM 106.3, north of Abaco Road, Key Largo. The project will cost an estimated \$1,140,724 and will last about seven months. Designed to improve maintenance and provide erosion control, the work will include installation of:

- Trees including palms
- Shrubs
- Groundcover and
- Grass

Diseased and deteriorated trees also will be removed and replaced.

To complete this work safely, it may be necessary to do short-term lane shifts and travel lane closures at times, mostly while landscaping materials are delivered. Closures will occur during non-peak hours, Sunday evening through Friday morning. Existing lanes will not be closed on a Saturday, a holiday, a Friday preceding a Saturday holiday or a Monday following a Sunday holiday. No lanes will be closed during special events as determined by the project engineer, or during tourist season (through April 20, 2015).
