Closure of Westbound West Flagler Street

Miami, *FL* — All westbound travel lanes on West Flagler Street will be closed in the area underneath State Road (SR) 826 on Tuesday, April 7, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. The southbound SR 826 exit ramp to West Flagler Street and eastbound West Flagler Street access to southbound SR 826 will also be closed during this time frame.

- Drivers on northbound SR 826 exiting at West Flagler Street heading west can:
 - Exit at West Flagler Street, go east
 - South on NW 72 Avenue, right on Tamiami Canal Drive to SW 8 Street
 - West on SW 8 Street
 - North on SW 87 Avenue to connect with West Flagler Street
- Westbound drivers on West Flagler Street can:
 - Enter southbound SR 826 to SW 8 Street west exit ramp
 - West on SW 8 Street
 - North on SW 87 Avenue to connect with West Flagler Street
- Drivers on southbound SR 826 going west on West Flagler Street can:
 - Exit at SW 8 Street west, go west
 - Go north on SW 87 Avenue to connect with West Flagler Street
- Drivers on southbound SR 826 going east on West Flagler Street can:
 - Exit at SW 8 Street east, enter northbound SR 826
 - Exit at West Flagler Street
- Drivers on eastbound West Flagler Street going south on SR 826 can:
 - Continue east on West Flagler Street, south on NW 72 Avenue
 - Turn right on Tamiami Canal Drive to SW 8 Street
 - West on SW 8 Street to access SR 826 south ramp

The closures will allow the contractor to pave the roadway. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
