## **Traffic Pattern Change and Lane Reduction on NW 84 Avenue at NW 25 Street**

---

**Doral, FL** – On Thursday, April 23, all traffic on NW 84 Avenue south of NW 25 Street will be shifted to the east side of the roadway between NW 23 Street and NW 25 Street. The lane configuration on NW 84 Avenue will be as follows:

**Lane configuration on NW 84 Avenue south of NW 25 Street:**

- **Northbound** travel lanes on NW 84 Avenue will have one lane north of NW 23 Street and will have one left and one right turn lane at NW 25 Street
- **Southbound** travel lanes will have one lane until north of NW 21 Street where it will open up to two lanes

This traffic pattern is expected to be in place for approximately one month and will allow the contractor to reconstruct the west side of NW 84 Avenue. In order to prepare for the traffic pattern change, the contractor will close one northbound lane on NW 84 Avenue between NW 23 Street and NW 25 Street on Wednesday, April 22, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
