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FDOT to Host Public Meeting for Two Roadway Safety Projects

State Road (SR) 5/SE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard

Miami, FL –The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six is developing the design for two roadway safety projects along SR 5/SE 2 Avenue from SE 2 Street to SE 4 Street and SR 5/Biscayne Boulevard from SE 3 Avenue to north of SE 2 Street, in Miami-Dade County.

The public information meeting will be held **from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 29, 2015 at First Presbyterian Church of Miami, 609 Brickell Avenue, Miami, Florida 33131**. Attendees may arrive at any time from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Graphic displays of the project will be shown and FDOT staff will be on hand to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for these projects includes:

- Repaving and resurfacing the road
- Modifying traffic signals
- Relocating a lighting pole
- Modifying connection of I-95 ramp to accommodate a pedestrian refuge island
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to current standards
- Installing pedestrian push buttons, high emphasis crosswalks, flashing beacons and curb ramps
- Adding signage and pavement markings

- Repaving and resurfacing the road
- Upgrading drainage to current standards
- Updating signage and pavement markings
- Adding a new bicycle lane and “Share the Road” pavement markings
- Replacing vehicle detectors at all intersections
- Replacing and relocating pedestrian signals at the intersections of SE 2 Street and Chopin Plaza to meet current standards
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to current standards

Construction is expected to begin in September 2017 and last about six months. The estimated construction cost of the projects is \$2.9 million.
