FDOT District Six to Host Alternatives Public Workshop For the Venetian Causeway PD&E Study

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will host an Alternatives Public Workshop for the Venetian Causeway Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study. The purpose of the proposed project is to address identified structural and functional deficiencies of the twelve existing bridges (ten low-level fixed spans and two movable bascules) through potential alternatives such as replacement or rehabilitation.

Graphics and aerial maps will be on display for public review, and representatives from the FDOT will be available to answer questions. The workshop will be held on Wednesday, May 13, 2015 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Miami Beach Botanical Garden, located at 2000 Convention Center Drive, Miami Beach, FL 33139. A formal presentation will begin at 7:30 p.m.
