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## Roadway Project Begins the Week of May 4

*State Road (SR) 9A/I-95*

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**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of May 4, 2015. The project area extends along southbound SR 9A/I-95 from NW 125 Street to NW 103 Street and northbound SR 9A/I-95 from NW 103 Street to NW 151 Street in Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$14.4 million. The work will last approximately 14 months and includes the following:

- Repairing the pavement
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Replacing plastic poles

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
