## Closure of Westbound NW 25 Street and Southbound and Northbound State Road (SR) 826 Ramp Lanes to Westbound NW 25 Street

*Miami, FL* – All westbound NW 25 Street travel lanes will be closed from State Road (SR) 826 to NW 78 Avenue Wednesday, April 29 through Tuesday, May 5 (excluding Sunday, May 3), between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:

- Go north on SR 826
- Exit at NW 36 Street, west on NW 36 Street
- South on NW 79 Avenue to connect with NW 25 Street

The southbound and northbound SR 826 ramp lanes to westbound NW 25 Street will also be closed Wednesday, April 29 through Tuesday, May 5 (excluding Sunday, May 3), between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

## Southbound drivers on SR 826 going west on NW 25 Street can:

- Exit at NW 36 Street, west on NW 36 Street
- South on NW 79 Avenue to connect with NW 25 Street

## Northbound drivers on SR 826 going west on NW 25 Street can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, go east, north on NW 72 Avenue
- West on NW 36 Street, south on NW 79 Avenue to connect with NW 25 Street

The closures will allow the contractor to place a steel bridge cap and bridge girders over the roadway. Please note that if the work is not completed due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions, the closure will occur on the following night.
