UPDATE: Full Nighttime Closure of West Flagler Street and Lane Closures on Northbound State Road (SR) 826

Miami, FL — All westbound and eastbound travel lanes on West Flagler Street will be closed in the area underneath State Road (SR) 826 on Friday, May 1 (Saturday, May 2 is an alternate date), between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

- Drivers on northbound SR 826 exiting at West Flagler Street heading west can:
 - Go east on West Flagler Street, south on NW 72 Avenue
 - Right on Tamiami Canal Road, west on SW 8 Street,
 - North on SW 87 Avenue to connect with West Flagler Street
- Westbound drivers on West Flagler Street can:
 - Access ramp to SR 826 north, exit at NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
 - North on Milam Dairy Road, west on NW 11 Street
 - Access the turn-around ramp for West Flagler Street/SR 826 south
 - Exit at West Flagler Street
- Eastbound drivers on West Flagler Street can:
 - Enter southbound SR 826
 - Exit SW 8 Street east
 - Enter northbound SR 826
 - Exit West Flagler Street
- Drivers on southbound SR 826 heading east on West Flagler can:
 - Exit SW 8 Street east
 - Enter northbound SR 826
 - Exit West Flagler Street

Two northbound lanes will be closed on SR 826 from SW 8 Street to north of West Flagler Street from 10 p.m., Friday, May 1 to 1 p.m., Saturday, May 2. At 1 p.m. on Saturday, May 2, one lane will be opened and the second lane will remain closed until 5 a.m., Monday, May 4.
