State Road (SR) 934/NW 79 Street/East 25 Street

Roadway Project Begins the Week of May 18

Miami, *FL* – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of May 18, 2015. The project limits extend along SR 934/NW 79 Street/East 25 Street from west of East 5 Avenue to the NW 2800 block in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$2 million. The work will take roughly seven months to complete and includes the following:

- Replacing sections of curb, gutter and sidewalk
- Installing new countdown pedestrian signals at intersections
- Performing signalization enhancements
- Repaying and restriping the roadway
- Installing new signage and pavement markings

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and implement detours at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving.
