UPDATE: Nighttime Full Closures of State Road (SR) 826 and NW 25 Street

Miami, FL – The following closures on SR 826, NW 25 Street and ramps leading to and from SR 826 will be scheduled to allow the contractor to work on the viaduct bridge over SR 826:

All northbound travel lanes on SR 826 will be closed at NW 25 Street Tuesday, May 19 and Wednesday, May 20 (Thursday, May 21 is an alternate night), between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

- Drivers on northbound SR 826 will be diverted to the NW 25 Street exit ramp
- Continue north through NW 25 Street and enter the northbound SR 826 entrance ramp

All southbound travel lanes on SR 826 will be closed at NW 25 Street on Tuesday, May 26 and Wednesday, May 27 (Thursday, May 28 and Friday, May 29 are alternate nights), between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

- Drivers on southbound SR 826 will be diverted to the NW 25 Street exit ramp
- Continue south through NW 25 Street and enter the southbound SR 826 entrance ramp
