Landscaping Project Begins the Week of May 25

State Road (SR) 968/West Flagler Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a landscaping project the week of May 25, 2015. The project area extends along SR 968/West Flagler Street from SW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road to SW 27 Avenue in the City of Miami. The project will cost an estimated \$205,000. The work will last roughly two months and includes the following:

- Installing palms within the new medians
- Installing trees/palms adjacent to sidewalks at select locations

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
