Roadway Project Begins the Week of June 15

State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue

Miami, *FL* – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of June 15, 2015. The project area extends along SR 977/Krome Avenue from SW 288 Street to SW 136 Street, excluding the segments of SW 272 Street to SW 268 Street and SW 192 Street to SW 184 Street in the City of Homestead and unincorporated Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$2 million. The work will last approximately four months and includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping the road
- Widening and repaving shoulders
- Installing signage and pavement markings
- Installing delineators (plastic poles) to enhance safety

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
