## **State Road (SR) 924/NW 119 Street**

*Roadway Project Begins the Week of June 22*

---

**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of June 22, 2015. The project limits extend along SR 924/NW 119 Street from SR 7/NW 7 Avenue to SR 909/West Dixie Highway in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$2,376,742. The work will take roughly eight months to complete and includes the following:

- Installing underground drainage structures and pipe
- Replacing sections of curb, gutter and sidewalk
- Rebuilding sections of roadway shoulder
- Rebuilding driveways
- Performing minor signalization work
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Installing new signage and pavement markings
- Planting new sod

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and establish permanent work zones. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
