Daytime Closure of NW 11 Street at NW 72 Avenue and NW 72 Avenue between NW 12 Street and NW 11 Street

Miami, *FL* – The following detours will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to reconstruct the intersection of NW 11 Street and NW 72 Avenue as well as open portions of the new westbound State Road (SR) 836 ramp to NW 72 Avenue:

Tuesday, August 18 through Thursday, August 20 (Friday, August 21 is an alternate date) - Eastbound NW 11 Street will be detoured to Milam Dairy Road as noted below, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Eastbound NW 11 Street will be opened to local business traffic.

Drivers on NW 11 Street going to NW 12 Street can:

- Go west on NW 11 Street
- Go north on Milam Dairy Road to connect with NW 12 Street

Thursday, August 20 (Friday, August 21 is an alternate date) - Southbound NW 72 Avenue traffic will be detoured to Milam Dairy Road, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Drivers on NW 12 Street going south on NW 72 Avenue can:

- Go west on NW 12 Street
- South on Milam Dairy Road to connect with NW 11 Street or access SR 836 ramps

Friday, August 21 - NW 72 Avenue will be closed between NW 11 Street and NW 12 between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Drivers on NW 12 Street/Perimeter Road going to NW 11 Street can:

• Go south on Milam Dairy Road to connect with NW 11 Street

Drivers on NW 11 Street going to NW 12 Street/Perimeter Road can:

- Go west on NW 11 Street
- Go north on Milam Dairy Road to connect with NW 12 Street

Drivers on westbound SR 836 exiting at NW 72 Avenue going to NW 11 Street can:

- Go north on NW 72 Avenue
- West on NW 12 Street
- South on Milam Dairy Road to connect with NW 11 Street

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
