UPDATE: Closure of State Road (SR) 836 Ramp to Southbound SR 826 and West Flagler Street

Miami, *FL* – The eastbound SR 836 ramp and flyover bridge to West Flagler Street/southbound SR 826 will be closed on Thursday, September 3, between the hours of 9 p.m. and midnight.

Drivers on the eastbound SR 836 ramp to West Flagler Street/southbound SR 826 can:

- Continue east on SR 836, exit at NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- South on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- West on West Flagler Street to connect with the southbound SR 826 ramp

Drivers on the eastbound SR 836 flyover bridge to southbound SR 826 can:

- Take the flyover bridge to northbound SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street
- Go west on NW 25 Street, to access the southbound SR 826 ramp

The closures will allow the contractor to place bridge beam adjacent to the roadway. **Please note** that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
