FDOT District Six to Host Public Meeting For the I-395 Reconstruction Project

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will host a public meeting for the I-395 Reconstruction Project. The purpose of the proposed project involves the rebuilding of the Interstate 395 (I-395) corridor from its terminus west of the I-95/Midtown Interchange (I-95/SR 836/I-395) to its corridor terminus at the West Channel Bridges of US 41/MacArthur Causeway, approximately 1.4 miles.

Graphics and aerial maps will be on display for public review, and representatives from the FDOT will be available to answer questions. The public meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 15, 2015 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Miami Dade College, Wolfson Campus, Room 7128, located at 300 NE 2 Avenue, Miami, FL 33132. A formal presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m.

The proposed work includes:

- Building new elevated ramps (one eastbound and one westbound) that will provide direct linkage between I-95 and I-395
- Improving roadway design including updating the alignment and upgrading the roadway surface
- Creating a visually appealing bridge
- Building vertically higher structures that will improve the visual quality of the bridge
