UPDATED: Closure of State Road (SR) 836 and SR 826 Ramps and NW 12 Street

Miami, FL – The following closures will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to paint bridges over the roadway:

Wednesday, September 9 - The westbound SR 836 ramps to West Flagler Street and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 11 p.m.

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to West Flagler Street:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue, go south, west on NW 11 Street
- South on Milam Dairy Road to West Flagler Street

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street can:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue, go south, west on NW 11 Street
- South on Milam Dairy Road to West Flagler Street
- West on West Flagler Street to NW 87 Avenue

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to westbound SR 836 can:

- West on NW 12 Street to access westbound SR 836 ramp after NW 87 Avenue

Wednesday, September 9 - The southbound SR 826 ramps to eastbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Continue south on SR 826
- Exit at SW 8 Street east
- Access the northbound SR 826 ramp
- Access ramp to eastbound SR 836

Wednesday, September 9 - All travel lanes on westbound and eastbound NW 12 Street between Milam Dairy Road and NW 82 Avenue will be closed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Drivers can on westbound NW 12 Street can:

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road, west on NW 25 Street
- South on NW 82 Avenue to connect with NW 12 Street

Drivers on eastbound NW 12 Street can:

- Go north on NW 82 Avenue, east on NW 25 Street
- South on Milam Dairy Road to connect with NW 12 Street
