## FDOT to hold Public Meeting for SR 7/NW 7 Avenue Roadway Improvement Project

From SR 934/NW 79 Street to Little River Drive

*Miami, FL* – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will conduct a public meeting for a roadway improvement project along State Road (SR) 7/NW 7 Avenue from SR 934/NW 79 Street to Little River Drive in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in November 2017 and last about four months. The estimated construction cost is \$819,000.

A public meeting will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 16, 2015 at the Arcola Lakes Public Library, 8240 NW 7 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33150. The meeting will follow an informal format that allows the public to arrive at any time from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project, answer questions, and receive comments about the proposed design.

The proposed work includes:

- Repaying and restriping the roadway
- Upgrading pavement markings and replacing signage to current standards
- Updating pedestrian curb ramps to current standards
- Installing new pedestrian countdown signals at Little River Drive
- Maintaining existing lane configurations
