FDOT to Host Public Meeting for a Landscape Project

State Road (SR) 5/Overseas Highway

Big Pine Key, FL – Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will hold a public meeting for a landscaping enhancement project along SR 5/Overseas Highway from South Pine Channel/Mile Marker (MM) 28.75 to Spanish Harbor/MM 32.98.

A public information meeting will be held **from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, September 22, 2015 at Big Pine United Methodist Church, Big Pine Key, FL 33043.** Attendees may arrive at any time from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Graphic displays of the project will be shown and FDOT staff will be on hand to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Enhancing aesthetics of the roadway
- Installing trees, palms & shrubs along the roadway shoulders
- Providing buffers for Florida Keys Overseas Heritage Trail

Construction is expected to begin in November 2016 and last about five months. The estimated construction cost of the project is \$548,400.
