NW 27 Avenue Closed for Railroad Crossing Repairs

Miami, FL – Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 26, 2015, until midnight, Monday, September 28, 2015, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Florida East Coast Railway (FEC) will close the railroad crossing located on SR 9/NW 27 Avenue (between NW 73 Street and NW 75 Street) in Miami-Dade County, for these days, weather permitting. During this time, all traffic will be detoured away from the NW 27 Avenue crossing and directed to follow signs to alternate local streets.

This detour is being established to allow workers to perform necessary repairs to the FEC Railway. During the closure, workers will replace the existing tracks and crossing surface to improve ride quality.

DETOUR INFORMATION: (see attached map)

Northbound Detour:

Northbound traffic main detour on NW 27 Avenue will be directed to make a left turn at NW 71 Street westbound, a right turn at NW 32 Avenue northbound, then traffic will make a right turn at NW 79 Street eastbound and will continue until NW 27 Avenue.

Southbound Detour:

Southbound traffic main detour on NW 27 Avenue will be directed to make a right turn at NW 79 Street westbound, a left turn at NW 32 Avenue southbound, then traffic will make a left turn at NW 71 Street eastbound and will continue until NW 27 Avenue.
