Roadway Project Begins the Week of September 21

NW 28 Street Eastward Extension to NW 37 Avenue

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of September 21, 2015. The project includes the extension of NW 28 Street between NW 39 Avenue and NW 37 Avenue at the Miami Intermodal Center (MIC) in the City of Miami. The project will cost an estimated \$2.4 million. The work will last roughly nine months and includes the following:

- Extending NW 28 Street to NW 37 Avenue and constructing a new signalized intersection at this location
- Constructing new roadway connecting NW 25 Street to NW 37 Avenue
- Widening NW 28 Street at LeJeune Road to extend the right turn lane
- Improving intersection to include left turn from eastbound NW 25 Street to southbound NW 42 Avenue/LeJeune Road
- Improving intersection of NW 25 Street and NW 39 Avenue to include left turn from southbound NW 38 Avenue to eastbound NW 25 Street
- Improving drainage
- Widening of the roadway
- Installing curb and gutter
- Installing new roadway signs and pavement markings
- Landscaping

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
