Closure of all NW 87 Avenue and Eastbound NW 25 Street Travel Lanes

Doral, FL – The following closures will be implemented as noted below to allow the contractor to place permanent asphalt on the south side of the NW 25 Street intersection with NW 87 Avenue and shift traffic on NW 87 Avenue to the east side of the road between NW 21 Terrace and NW 27 Street.

All northbound and southbound travel lanes on NW 87 Avenue will be closed between NW 25 Street and NW 21 Terrace on Sunday, October 4, between the hours of 5 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Drivers on northbound NW 87 Avenue can:

- West on NW 21 Terrace, north on NW 88 Court
- West on NW 23 Street, north on NW 89 Place
- East on NW 25 Street, north on NW 89 Court
- East on NW 27 Street to connect with NW 87 Avenue

Drivers on southbound NW 87 Avenue can:

- Go west on NW 25 Street south on NW 89 Place, east on NW 23 Street
- South on NW 88 Court, east on NW 21 Terrace to go south on NW 87 Avenue

All eastbound travel lanes on NW 25 Street will be closed at NW 89 Court Sunday, October 4, between the hours of 5 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Eastbound drivers on NW 25 Street going to northbound NW 87 Avenue or NW 25 Street can:

- Go north on NW 89 Court
- East on NW 27 Street, go north on NW 87 Avenue, **OR**
- Continue east on NW 27 Street, south on NW 82 Avenue to NW 25 Street

Eastbound drivers on NW 25 Street going to southbound NW 87 Avenue can:

- Go south on NW 89 Place, east on NW 23 Street
- South on NW 88 Court, east on NW 21 Terrace to go south on NW 87 Avenue

Access to local traffic will be provided. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
