## Nighttime Lane Closures on Eastbound NW 25 Street at NW 82 Avenue

*Doral, FL* – All eastbound NW 25 Street travel lanes will be closed from NW 82 Avenue to NW 78 Avenue on Monday, October 5 and Tuesday, October 6, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Access will be provided to local businesses. Drivers can:

- Turn north on NW 82 Avenue
- Turn east on NW 36 Street, enter SR 826 south
- Exit at NW 25 Street

The southbound NW 79 Avenue turn lane to eastbound NW 25 Street will also be closed on Monday, October 5 and Tuesday, October 6, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:

- Go west on NW 25 Street, turn north on NW 82 Avenue
- Turn east on NW 36 Street, enter SR 826 south
- Exit at NW 25 Street

One lane on eastbound NW 25 Street will be closed nightly from NW 82 Avenue to NW 78 Avenue on Wednesday, October 7 through Saturday, October 10, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The lane closures will allow the contractor to install bridge girders over the roadway. **Please note that if the work is not completed due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions, the closure will occur on the following night.**
