## Nighttime Lane Closures on Eastbound NW 25 Street, Viaduct and State Road (SR) 826 Ramps to NW 25 Street

---

**Doral, FL** – The following closures will be scheduled on NW 25 Street to allow the contractor to work on an overhead bridge:

**The eastbound travel lanes on the NW 25 Street viaduct will closed on Wednesday, October 14 (Thursday, October 15 is an alternate date), between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:**

- East on NW 25 Street, south on NW 67 Avenue to access the Miami International Airport Cargo Area

**The two left turn lanes on the northbound SR 826 exit ramp to go west on NW 25 Street will be closed Wednesday, October 14 (Thursday, October 15 is an alternate date), between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Go east on NW 25 Street, turn north on NW 72 Avenue, west on NW 36 Street
- Turn south on NW 79 Avenue to access NW 25 Street

**The southbound SR 826 ramp lane to eastbound NW 25 Street will be closed Wednesday, October 14 (Thursday, October 15 is an alternate date), between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Exit at NW 36 Street, west on NW 36 Street
- South on NW 79 Avenue to connect with NW 25 Street

**One eastbound lane will be closed from NW 78 Avenue to east of SR 826 Wednesday, October 14, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.**
