NW 36 Street Closed Between Le Jeune Road and North River Drive

October 16, 11 p.m. - October 18, 7 a.m.

Miami, FL – All eastbound and westbound lanes on State Road (SR) 948/NW 36 Street between SR 953/NW 42 Avenue/Le Jeune Road and North River Drive will be closed continuously from 11 p.m., Friday, October 16 until 7 a.m., Sunday, October 18. During the closure, the following detours will be in use:

- Drivers who want to go west on NW 36 Street should go north on Okeechobee Road to SE 9 Court; go north on SE 9 Court to SE 8 Street; go west on SE 8 Street to Le Jeune Road; go south on Le Jeune Road to NW 36 Street
- Drivers who want to go east on NW 36 Street should go north on Royal Poinciana Boulevard to Le Jeune Road; go north on Le Jeune Road to Okeechobee Road; go east on Okeechobee Road to NW 36 Street
- Drivers who want to exit SR 112/Airport Expressway at NW 36 Street should continue westbound on SR 112 to Le Jeune Road; go south on Le Jeune Road to NW 28 Street; go east on NW 28 Street to NW 40 Avenue; go north on NW 40 Avenue to NW 29 Street; go west on NW 29 Street to Le Jeune Road and continue north to NW 36 Street

This continuous closure will allow workers to place concrete for a new bridge deck and allow the concrete to cure.
