## **State Road (SR) 836 to SR 826 Ramp Closures for a Traffic Shift**

---

**Miami, FL** – On Saturday morning, October 24, the westbound and eastbound SR 836 ramp lane to southbound SR 826 will be re-aligned to the west to allow the contractor to construct a concrete median separator wall. In order to re-align the ramp lane, the following closures will be implemented:

**The westbound and eastbound SR 836 flyover bridges to southbound SR 826 will be closed Friday, October 23, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Go north on SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street
- West on NW 25 Street to access the SR 826 south entrance ramp

**The eastbound SR 836 ramp to West Flagler Street/SR 826 south will be closed on Friday, October 23, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Continue east on SR 836, exit at NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- South on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- West on West Flagler Street to access with the southbound SR 826 ramp

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
