Closure of State Road (SR) 826 and SR 836 Ramps

Miami, *FL* – The flowing closures will be implemented as noted below to allow the contactor to place asphalt on the roadway:

The NW 87 Avenue ramp to eastbound SR 836 will be closed Wednesday, October 28 and Thursday, October 29, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Go south on SR 826 flyover bridge, exit at the SW 8 Street east ramp
- Go north on SR 826, exit at the eastbound SR 836 ramp

The westbound SR 836 ramp and southbound SR 826 ramps to West Flagler Street will be closed on Wednesday, October 28 and Thursday, October 29, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street, go west on NW 12 Street
- Go south on NW 87 Avenue to connect with West Flagler Street

The southbound SR 826 ramps to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road will be closed on Wednesday, October 28 and Thursday, October 29, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street, go west on NW 12 Street
- Go south on NW 87 Avenue to West Flagler Street
- East on West Flagler Street to connect with NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
