FDOT to hold Public Meeting for Krome Avenue Reconstruction Project

From south of SW 296 Street to south of SW 232 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will hold a public meeting for a roadway reconstruction and widening project along State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue from south of SW 296 Street to south of SW 232 Street in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in August 2019 and last for a time that is yet to be determined. The estimated construction cost of the project is \$34 million.

The public meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, November 5, 2015, at Redland Golf & Country Club, located at 24451 SW 177 Avenue, Homestead, Florida 33030. Attendees may arrive at any time from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Graphic displays of the project will be shown and FDOT staff will be on hand to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Reconstructing and widening Krome Avenue from a two-lane roadway to a four-lane roadway divided by a grassed median
- Replacing the C-103 Canal/Mowry Bridge
- Installing a drainage system
- Installing lighting along the length of the project
- Installing guardrail in the median along the length of the project
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Modifying access to various entrances to enhance safety along the corridor
