State Road (SR) 924/NW 119 Street

Partial Closure of Intersections Continue for Drainage Work

Miami, FL – Continuing through December 17, the contractor for the SR 924/NW 119 Street project will partially close the southern leg of the intersections at NW 1 Avenue, NW 2 Avenue and NW 3 Avenue in order to install new drainage pipe across the roadway. This work will only impact drivers traveling northbound and southbound on the avenues. Travel lanes will not be closed along NW 119 Street. The contractor will only partially close one intersection at a time. Each closure will be continuous until the work is complete.

Detours will be established for drivers traveling on the three avenues to get around the work.

- Drivers traveling north or south on NW 1 Avenue who wish to cross NW 119 Street will be detoured to NW 2 Avenue or North Miami Avenue.
- Drivers traveling north or south on NW 2 Avenue who wish to cross NW 119 Street will be detoured to NW 3 Avenue or NW 1 Avenue.
- Drivers traveling north or south on NW 3 Avenue who wish to cross NW 119 Street will be detoured to NW 5 Avenue or NW 2 Avenue.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
