## **Rescheduled: Westbound State Road (SR) SR 836 Mainline Closure**

---

**Miami, FL** – The following closure will be implemented to install sign panels over westbound SR 836:

**All westbound SR 836 travel lanes will be closed at NW 57 Avenue on Monday, November 23 (Tuesday, November 24 is an alternate night), between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:**

- Exit at NW 57 Avenue, go south
- West on NW 7 Avenue, north on Milam Dairy Road
- West on NW 11 Street to access SR 836 west ramp

**Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 72 Avenue or Milam Dairy Road can:**

- Exit at NW 57 Avenue, go south
- West on NW 7 Street to connect with Milam Dairy Road

Or

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road, east on NW 11 Street to connect with NW 72 Avenue

**Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to West Flagler Street can:**

- Exit at NW 57 Avenue, go south to connect with West Flagler Street

**Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 87 Avenue can:**

- Exit at NW 57 Avenue, go south
- West on NW 7 Street, north on Milam Dairy Road
- West on NW 11 Street to access SR 836 west ramp and exit at the NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street ramp

**Westbound drivers on SR 836 going north or south on SR 826 can:**

- Exit at NW 57 Avenue, go south
- West on NW 7 Street, north on Milam Dairy Road
- West on NW 11 Street to access SR 836 west ramp and access north or south SR 826 ramps
