FDOT to hold Public Hearing for Two Roadway Projects

State Road (SR) 992/SW 152 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will hold a public hearing for two roadway improvement projects along SR 992/SW 152 Street from SR 821/HEFT/Florida's Turnpike northbound ramp to SR 5/US 1, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in March 2017 and last for about 280 days. The estimated construction cost of the projects is \$3.1 million.

The public hearing will be held **from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, December 3, 2015, at Coral Reef Park, located at 7895 SW 152 Street, Palmetto Bay, FL 33157.** The hearing will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for these projects includes:

- Repaying and restriping the road
- Upgrading pedestrian ramps to current standards
- Replacing isolated drainage structures
- Modifying the median at the intersections of SW 102 Avenue and SW 107 Avenue
- Upgrading signs as needed
- Improving signalization such as replacement of pedestrian signals and traffic loops at signalized intersections
- Installing two permanent traffic count sites
- Repairing the bridge deck
- Widening existing westbound outside lane from east of SW 93 Avenue to SW 93 Avenue to realign roadway

- Extending the eastbound left turn lane at US 1
- Providing an exclusive left turn lane for the public library
- Modifying the existing driveway entrance at Jackson South Community Hospital
- Installing signing and pavement markings, including high emphasis crosswalks and pedestrian signage
- Removing the out of service bus bay and a portion of sidewalk located along the west side of US 1 immediately south of SW 152 Street
- Providing landscape barrier along with a pedestrian scale fence to direct pedestrian traffic to the designated crosswalk
