Roadway Project Begins the Week of January 11

State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Expressway

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of January 11, 2016. The project area extends along SR 826/Palmetto Expressway from SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway to north of SR 986/SW 72 Street/Sunset Drive in Miami-Dade County. The project will cost an estimated \$3.84 million. The work will last approximately seven months and includes the following:

- Repaving and restriping the road including the entrance and exit ramps at SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive and SR 986/SW 72 Street/Sunset Drive
- Installing signage
- Replacing guardrail
- Upgrading pedestrian ramps and traffic islands on the south side of SR 986/SW 72 Street/Sunset Drive

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and detour traffic at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
