## FDOT to Host Public Meeting for a Landscape Improvement Project

State Road (SR) 5/Overseas Highway at Summerland Key from Mile Marker (MM) 23.69 to MM 25.40

*Miami*, *FL* – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing the design for a landscape improvement project along SR 5/Overseas Highway at Summerland Key from MM 23.69 to MM 25.40, in Monroe County. This project will cost an estimated \$500,000. Construction is expected to begin in June 2017 and last about seven months.

A public meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, January 14, 2016 at the Big Pine United Methodist Church, 280 Key Deer Blvd., Big Pine Key, FL, 33043. The meeting will be an open house, from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes:

- Installing large trees and palms to improve the aesthetics of the roadway
- Adding a landscape buffer along the roadway
- Removing and replacing diseased and damaged trees
