## Westbound NE 203 Street Closed for Railroad Crossing Repairs

*Miami-Dade County, FL* – Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 16, 2016 until 6:00 a.m. Tuesday, January 19, 2016, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Florida East Coast Railway (FEC) will close the railroad crossing located on NE 203 Street (between Biscayne Boulevard and West Dixie Highway) for these days, weather permitting.

During this time, all traffic will be detoured away from NE 203 Street and directed to follow signs to alternate local streets.

This detour is being established to allow workers to perform necessary repairs to the FEC Railway. During the closure, workers will replace the existing tracks and crossing surface to improve ride quality.

Traffic traveling westbound on NE 203 Street (at-grade) will be directed onto NE 203 Street (elevated). Traffic will (turn right) proceed northbound on Biscayne Boulevard. Traffic will then (turn left) proceed westbound on NE 209 Street. Traffic will then (turn right) proceed northbound on East Dixie Highway. Traffic will then (turn left) proceed westbound on NE 215 Street. Traffic will then (turn left) proceed southbound on West Dixie Highway back to NE 203 Street.

The northbound ramp from Biscayne Boulevard to westbound NE 203 Street will be closed. This traffic will be directed northbound on Biscayne Boulevard to NE 209 Street and then follow same detour as described above.

The southbound ramp from Biscayne Boulevard to westbound NE 203 Street will be closed. This traffic will be directed southbound on Biscayne Boulevard to NE 186 Street/Miami Gardens Drive. Traffic will then (turn right) proceed westbound on NE 186 Street to West Dixie Highway/NE 26 Avenue. Traffic will travel northbound on West Dixie Highway/NE 26 Avenue back to NE 203 Street.

## Eastbound traffic on NE 203 Street will not be affected.
