Closure of Westbound State Road (SR) 836 Ramps to NW 72 Avenue, West Flagler Street and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street

Miami, *FL* – The westbound SR 836 ramps to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road, West Flagler Street and NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street will be closed on Thursday, January 28 and Friday, January 29, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. The ramp from Milam Dairy Road to westbound SR 836 will also be closed during this timeframe.

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road and West Flagler Street:

- Go north on SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street
- East on NW 25 Street, south NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- Continue south to West Flagler Street

Westbound drivers on SR 836 going to NW 87 Avenue/NW 12 Street can:

- Go north on SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street
- East on NW 25 Street, south NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- West on NW 12 Street to NW 87 Avenue

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to westbound SR 836 can:

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road, west on NW 12 Street
- Access the westbound SR 836 entrance ramp after NW 87 Avenue

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to northbound SR 826 can:

- Go north on Milam Dairy Road to NW 25 Street
- West on NW 25 Street to access northbound SR 826 ramp

Drivers on Milam Dairy Road going to southbound SR 826 can:

- Go south on Milam Dairy Road to West Flagler Street
- West on West Flagler Street to access the southbound SR 826 ramp
