## State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway in Key Largo

Lighting Project Begins the Week of February 8

*Monroe County, FL* – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a lighting project the week of February 8, 2016. The project limits extend along SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway from Atlantic Boulevard (MM 99.5) to Tarpon Basin Drive (MM 101.5) in Key Largo, Monroe County. The project will cost an estimated \$440,000 and will take roughly five months to complete.

The project includes installing new street lights along Overseas Highway from Atlantic Boulevard to Ocean Drive and from Hibiscus Lane to Tarpon Basin Drive in Key Largo.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel and turn lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
