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Landscaping Project Begins the Week of February 15

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a landscaping project the week of February 15, 2016. The project area extends along SR 9A/I-95 from just north of SR 860/NE 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive to the Miami-Dade/Broward County Line. The project will cost an estimated \$2.88 million. The construction work will last approximately nine months and includes the following:

- Installing palms, trees and shrubs
- Removing and replacing diseased and damaged trees

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.
