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## FDOT to Host Public Meeting for a Roadway Improvement Project

State Road (SR) 968/West Flagler Street and SR 9/SW/NW 27 Avenue

*Miami, FL* – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will host a public meeting for a roadway improvement project along SR 968/West Flagler Street from SR 9/27 Avenue to 14 Avenue and SR 9/SW/NW 27 Avenue from SW 10 Street to NW 9 Street in the City of Miami. Construction is scheduled to begin during the week of March 28, 2016 and last approximately two years. The estimated construction cost is \$14.24 million.

A public meeting will be held **from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, February 23, 2016 at the Manuel Artime Theater, 900 SW 1 Street, Miami, FL 33130.** The meeting will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work along SR 968/West Flagler Street includes:

- Reconstructing the roadway
- Installing new lighting, traffic signals and pavement markings
- Adding an exclusive bicycle and shared-use lane
- Providing new sidewalks and pedestrian ramps
- Installing new storm water drainage structures

The proposed work along SR 9/SW/NW 27 Avenue includes:

- Repaying and restriping the roadway
- Installing new traffic signals
- Extending the traffic separators at SW 5 Street, SW 4 Street and SW 1 Street
- Installing an island median at SW 3 Street and NW 1 Street
- Converting the inner through lane on southbound/northbound SW 27 Avenue to an additional left-turn lane at the intersection of SW 8 Street
- Extending the left-turn lane on southbound/northbound NW 27 Avenue at the intersection of NW 7 Street
