Closures on State Road (SR) 826 and SR 836

Miami, FL – The following closures will be implemented to allow the contractor to paint overhead bridges:

The eastbound SR 836 exit ramp to NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road/West Flagler Street will be closed on Thursday, February 18, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 11:45 p.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at the SR 826 ramp immediately after NW 87 Avenue
- Access the southbound SR 826 ramp, south on SR 826
- Exit at SW 8 Street east exit, go north on SR 826 to exit at West Flagler Street or NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road

The NW 87 Avenue ramp to eastbound SR 836 will be closed on Thursday, February 18, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 11:45 p.m. Drivers can:

- Access the southbound SR 826 ramp, south on SR 826
- Exit at SW 8 Street east exit, go north on SR 826 to the eastbound SR 836 ramp

The westbound SR 836 turn around ramp that allows drivers to exit at West Flagler Street/SR 826 south will be closed on Thursday, February 18, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 11:45 p.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at the NW 12 Street/NW 87 Avenue exit, go west on NW 12 Street
- South on NW 87 Avenue to West Flagler Street, east to access the southbound SR 826 ramp

All southbound lanes will be closed at the exit ramp to NW 12 Street/NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road on Thursday, February 18, between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at the NW 12 Street/NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road ramp
- Follow the signs to the West Flagler Street/SR 826 south turn around ramp

The westbound SR 836 flyover bridge to southbound SR 826 will be closed on Thursday, February 18, between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

- Go north on SR 826, exit at NW 25 Street, go west
- Access the SR 826 southbound ramp

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
