95 Express Phase 2 Toll Testing Begins March 6

Southbound I-95 in Miami-Dade County

Fort Lauderdale, FL – Beginning on Sunday, March 6, new toll pricing signs along southbound I-95 between Ives Dairy Road and the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County will start posting "\$0.00" to Florida's Turnpike and SR 826, signaling the start of toll testing along this corridor, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) officials announced. The new pricing signs currently show "No Toll" to Florida's Turnpike and SR 826 and the actual toll rate for toll-paying drivers to take 95 Express to SR 112, SR 836 and I-395.

- SunPass® customers will begin to see a "\$0.00" charge for this area on their statements.
- Tolls on 95 Express are collected electronically so toll-paying users of the express lanes must properly affix a SunPass[®] transponder to their windshield.
- Drivers entering the express lanes should monitor the electronic pricing signs that notify what the toll is to upcoming exits. Note that the pricing sign located on southbound I-95, just south of Ives Dairy Road, provides pricing information for drivers that are already in the express lanes as well as for drivers in the general use lanes who are considering entering the express lanes south of Ives Dairy Road.
