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State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue and SR 934/NW 79 Street Roadway Projects Finish Ahead of Schedule

Projects Reach Completion Before Last Contract Day

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) successfully reached early completion of two projects in north Miami-Dade County on December 17, 2015. The projects, on SR 9/NW 27 Avenue and SR 934/NW 79 Street, were completed roughly 51 days before the last contract day. The contractor, General Asphalt, received an incentive bonus to complete work ahead of schedule. The SR 9/NW 27 Avenue project extended from NW 79 Street to NW 103 Street and the SR 934/NW 79 Street project was between the NW 2800 block and NW 14 Avenue. Both projects started on January 12, 2015, and included approximately \$7.3 million in roadway and drainage improvements that included:

- New underground drainage structures and pipes
- Replaced sections of curb, gutter and sidewalk
- New countdown pedestrian signals at intersections
- Modified existing median locations
- New lighting along the roadway
- Rebuilt sections of roadway
- Repaved and restriped the roadway
- New signage and pavement markings
- Added signals at major intersections

These projects were final accepted by the department on December 17, 2015. The early completion of these projects demonstrates FDOT's continued commitment to improving the community's roads.
